# Multiple firms in cross-border Andean telecoms loan

Morrison & Foerster LLP in New York, Chile's Guerrero Olivos and Garrigues' offices in Lima and Bogotá have helped telecoms group Andean Telecom Partners (ATP) obtain a US\$170 million credit facility to fund its operations in Chile, Colombia and Peru.

Gómez-Pinzón in Bogotá and Philippi Prietocarrizosa Ferrero DU & Uría (Chile) advised a syndicate of lenders led by Scotiabank for the deal, which closed on 6 August.

The loan was made in several tranches and divided between ATP's three subsidiaries in Chile, Colombia and Peru. The value of each tranche was not disclosed.

The borrower will use the loan to purchase telecoms and infrastructure equipment for its local operations as well as for general corporate purposes.

ATP operates and leases out telecommunication towers, fibre networks and rooftop masts among other facilities and is among the largest digital infrastructure companies in Latin America. It is owned by US private equity company Digital Colony, which holds over US\$20 billion assets under management.
