# Globalvía acquires Chilean motorway projects from Brookfield

Spanish transport concessionaire Globalvía has hired Barros & Errázuriz Abogados to purchase a minority stake in two Chilean motorway projects from Canadian investor Brookfield Americas Infrastructure.

Latin Lawyer understands that Brookfield turned to Carey in Santiago, but this could not be confirmed before publication.

The deal, the value of which is confidential, was signed on 14 September.

In the transaction, Globalvía acquires a 34% stake in two Chilean road projects: the Vespucio Norte Express and Túnel San Cristóbal. Vespucio is a 29-kilometre stretch of motorway, while the second project consists of two 1.8-kilometre tunnels. Both concessions are in Santiago and its suburbs.

Chilean concessionaires Apoquindo and Infraestructura Alpha each control a third of the two concessions.

Infrastructure concessions manager Globalvía is present in eight countries, including Chile, Costa Rica and Mexico. The latest acquisition adds to Globalvía's existing holdings in Chile, where it already manages Autopista del Itata, a motorway connecting Concepción and Chillán; Autopista del Aconcagua, which runs between Santiago and Los Vilos; and coastal road Autopista Costa Arauco, south of Concepción.

Brookfield is one of the world's largest infrastructure investors, owning and operating assets across the utilities, transport, midstream and data sectors. The fund has US\$95 billion worth of assets under management, including US\$44 billion in Brazil, Chile, Colombia and Peru.

Back in April, an investment fund, controlled by Brookfield and Brazilian finance group Itaúsa, **paid** US\$340 million for Petrobras' remaining stake in local gas pipeline operator Nova Transportadora do Sudeste.
