# Sonnedix awarded 39% of capacity in Chilean electric power auction

Global independent electric power generator Sonnedix has been awarded 39% of the total capacity made available in Chile's latest power auction.

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The company was awarded contracts for 903 GWh/year, equivalent to 39% of the total on offer in the tender, in which 29 Chilean and foreign generating companies participated.

The tender, which reached a new historical low of \$23.39 per MWh on average, auctioned 2,310 GWh to supply the energy needs of regulated customers of the country's grid (SEN) for a 15-year period starting in 2026.

Axel Thiemann, CEO of Sonnedix, said that seeing renewable energy companies among the winners of the tender "shows the importance of this sector in the national energy matrix".

For Sonnedix, this award is an excellent opportunity for the company to expand its presence in Chile, allowing it to build around 424 MW of solar photovoltaic projects, and investing approximately \$300 million, Thiemann said.

In addition to Chile, Sonnedix also has a presence in the Netherlands, South Africa, Japan, the UK and the US.

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The company currently has 4.7 GW of total capacity installed and in operation, including a development and construction pipeline of over 3 GW as it continues to actively seek development and acquisition opportunities across OECD countries.

Sonnedix was advised on the preparation of its bid in the auction by law firm Guerrero Olivos.
